Both had already been approved by SSC at the end of last year.</p> <p>Principal Moreno presented the Roles and Responsibilities of the SSC. (see powerpoint handout)</p>
<p>11. Data Review a. SBAC test scores for 18-19</p>	Informational	<p>Principal Moreno shared 18-19 SBAC data. Edison has seen five consecutive years of growth in English Language Arts and Math. Subgroup data was presented. Students with Disabilities continues to be an area of concern however, the test is given at grade level and the supports/accommodations are minimal. A comparison of students in the Bilingual program and English program shows that the Bilingual students had a higher rate of met/exceeded standard in both Language Arts and Math. For the four year in a row, Edison is the highest performing school in the Hoover Cluster in both ELA and math. If we include Crawford Cluster which incorporates the rest of City Heights, Edison has the second highest results.</p>

		Directora Moreno presentó los Roles y Responsabilidades del SSC. (ver folleto de powerpoint)
4. Data Review a. SBAC test scores for 18-19	Informational	Directora Moreno compartió datos del examen estatal SBAC 18-19. Edison ha visto cinco años consecutivos de crecimiento en lectoescritura y matemáticas. Se presentaron datos de subgrupos. Los estudiantes con discapacidades continúan siendo un área de preocupación, sin embargo, el examen se realiza a nivel de grado y los apoyos / adaptaciones son mínimos. Una comparación de los estudiantes en el programa bilingüe y el programa de inglés muestra que los estudiantes bilingües tuvieron una tasa más alta de estándar cumplido / excedido tanto en artes del lenguaje como en matemáticas. Por cuatro años consecutivos, Edison es la escuela de mejor desempeño en el Hoover Cluster, tanto en ELA como en matemáticas. Si incluimos Crawford Cluster que incorpora el resto de City Heights, Edison tiene los segundos resultados más altos.
